

The Parks Library Repair Café

Disclaimer Repairee Agreement

A 'repairee' referred to below is a person(s) bringing an item for repair. Where this is not the person who owns the item, the repairee must obtain written permission of the owner to bring the item on their behalf for assessment and, where possible, repair.

1. All repairs carried out at the Parks Library Repair Café are performed free of charge on a voluntary basis by the repairers. Voluntary donations of tools, materials and components are welcome for repairers and the development of future Repair Café events
2. Repairees are encouraged to work with the repairers whenever practical to see how the repair is being done and to pick up new skills or new interests.
3. Repairees are expected to remain for the duration of the repair being carried out. Items should not be left with the repairer for collection at a later time, except by special arrangement with the volunteer.
4. Neither the Parks Library Repair Café nor the repairers are liable for any loss or injury that may result from any repair carried out at the Café or for any advice or instructions given and used at a later date.
5. The repairee is responsible for providing any consumables such as leads, plugs, fuses, zips, etc. that may be needed to fully complete a repair.
6. Repairers offer no guarantee for any repairs carried out with or without their help, and are not liable if any repaired items do not work properly at home or break down again in the future.
7. After making an initial assessment of an item, repairers are fully entitled to use their discretion and refuse to repair an item should they decide to do so. When a professional repair service is needed, Parks Library Repair Café will, if possible, suggest a local provider.
8. Repairers are at liberty to refuse to repair and/or reassemble any appliances that are deemed to be hazardous, semi-hazardous or beyond repair.
9. Repairees are responsible for the removal of all items that cannot be repaired.
10. Normally, a maximum of ONE item per person will be examined. Should time allow, extra items can be considered for repair.
11. Parents will be held responsible for the behaviour and safety of their children whilst at the Parks Library Repair Café.
12. Repairers and repairees consent to photographs/video taken at the Parkes Library Repair Café being used for publicity purposes. Please make it clear to the photographer if you do NOT wish your photograph/video to be used in this way.
